

Adult and Children's Behavioral Health Services

Services are offered at our outpatient clinics, in schools, and in the community, and address mood disorders, situational or phase of life difficulties, parenting and family life issues, etc.

HomePlace Clinic

Federally Qualified Health Centers located in Paintsville, Prestonsburg, Pikeville, Belfry, Louisa, Inez, Grayson, and Cynthiana. HomePlace Clinic provides primary care, referrals, disease management, etc.

Therapeutic Foster Care

Provides temporary homes for abandoned, neglected, or abused children who were removed from their parents or other guardians.

Addiction Services

Outpatient addiction services are provided at many of our locations. Residential treatment is available at Mountain Center for Recovery & Hope (Prestonsburg), Serenity House (Inez), Hope House (Owensboro), and Cliffview (Lancaster).

Housing

Provides housing assistance, transitional living for veterans and others, and apartments for homeless individuals. Utilizes our services to help people overcome barriers and housing-related issues.

Developmental/Intellectual Disability Services

Community based services for children and adults with D/I disabilities. Includes First Steps, Case Management, Michelle P. Waiver, Adult Day Training, etc.

Supported Employment

Services that helps people join the competitive labor market, including veterans with PTSD, people with severe mental illness, intellectual disabilities, addiction disorders, etc.

Healing Program

Specializes in services to survivors of sexual assault and domestic violence. Healing Program offers free legal and medical advocacy, and Safe Haven, a supervised visitation/exchange facility.

Community Support

Services to help individuals manage major mental illness, such as schizophrenia, bipolar disorder, major depression, and other disorders.

Crisis Stabilization

Our 24 hour helpline provides urgent assistance. Includes Riverside Adult CSU and Creekside Children's CSU for short term crises.
