- **Reward dollars** that can be redeemed in the form of gift cards from stores such as Amazon, Home Depot, and Barnes & Noble. Healthy Rewards allows you to earn rewards just for going to checkups and health screenings.
- The New Baby, New You prenatal program, which includes:
 - Healthy Rewards for going to prenatal and postpartum checkups on time.



- No-cost crib or car seat after completing six prenatal visits.
- Books for babies.
- Mail-order diapers (one pack of 200 diapers).
- Breastfeeding support kit.
